Upgrade E-adults is an international Erasmus + strategic partnership cooperation project for innovation and exchange of good practices that aims to disseminate good practices at European level. This is to be done through the training of trainers, who can provide digital skills, particularly in the use of social networks applied to the world of work, to disadvantaged adults. Education is a priority across the generations. Research points out the urgent need to focus adult education from basic skills including the mathematical and digital skills and to add others. Development of digital skills contribute positively to the availability of professional opportunities and involvement in social life. "Having sufficient levels of basic skills (literacy, numeracy, science and technology) is essential for young people to smoothly access the labour market and for adults to retain employment in high quality and stable jobs."
